SYMPOSIUM PRESENTATION

The LAS 2024 Symposium is a scientific-technical multidisciplinary event, organized by the LAS/ANS with the support of TDN (Consulting, Communication and Marketing firm). It aims to bring together professionals working in energy generation and use, with emphasis in the peaceful use of nuclear energy.

PAPER GUIDELINES

Papers may be written in English, Spanish or Portuguese languages and will be delivered at the Symposium either in person or virtually. Their extension should not exceed 10 pages in a A4 format and should be delivered within the time limit allocated in the program. Their presentation can also be delivered in Power Point (ppt).

All approved papers will be published in the proceedings of the Symposium to be posted on the LAS/ANS website.
